

RESOLUTION 640

CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION DECREASING THE SPEED LIMIT ON A PORTION OF RUDELL ROAD FROM 18TH AVENUE SE TO MULLEN ROAD SE.

WHEREAS, it has been determined on the basis of engineering and traffic investigation that although the maximum speed permitted by state law is insufficient, the maximum speed previously set by Resolution No. 230 of the City of Lacey on that portion of Ruddell Road from 18th Avenue SE to Mullen Road SE is higher than reasonable and safe under the conditions now found to exist, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section 1. The speed limit on Ruddell Road from 18th Avenue SE to Mullen Road SE shall be 35 miles per hour.

Section 2. Resolution No. 230 of the City of Lacey setting speed limits on various street as amended, is further amended to the extent set forth in this Resolution.

Section 3. The speed limit established by this Resolution shall be effective on said street set forth herein at such time as appropriate signs giving notice thereof are erected by the City.
