

RESOLUTION 644

CITY OF LACEY

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR AN AQUATIC LAND ENHANCEMENT ACCOUNT PROJECT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.

WHEREAS, the city council for the City of Lacey has approved a "Comprehensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the urban area which identifies acquisition and development of waterfront property as a city priority; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 79.24.580, RCW, state funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land and the construction of facilities for public access to and aquatic land enhancement of state owned aquatic lands; and

WHEREAS, the city council of the City of Lacey considers it in the best interest of the public to develop Long Lake Park located off Carpenter Road and adjacent to the County Fairgrounds on the eastern city limits; and

WHEREAS, adequate notification has been given and opportunity provided for public input into the development of the city's plan and published notices have identified any affected flood plains or wetlands; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City Manager is authorized to make formal

application to the Department of Natural Resources for funding assistance to be used in the development of Long Lake Park;

2. That the city's share of funds for the project will be from sources identified by the City Manager;

3. That the property developed with financial aid through the Aquatic Land Enhancement account will be used in accordance with the terms of the grant; and

4. That this resolution become part of a formal application to the Department of Natural Resources.
