A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE LACEY
TIMBERLAND LIBRARY

WHEREAS, pursuant to advertisement by the City of Lacey, sealed bids for construction of the Lacey Timberland Library were received and opened and read on February 27, 1990, and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid submitted which included bid amounts for the alternate bid items needed by the City was submitted by Andy Johnson and Company and said low bid has been examined and found to be legally acceptable and the City Manager has recommended award of the bid to said company as the lowest responsible bidder; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the contract for construction of the Lacey Timberland Library be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, Andy Johnson and Company for the base bid plus alternates A-1, A-2, A-3a, A-3d, A-3h, and A-3j, in the total sum of \$1,741,858.28, including all applicable sales taxes, and the City Manager is authorized to execute said contract on behalf of the City of Lacey.
