

Resolution 690

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE LACEY FEE SCHEDULE TO PROVIDE FOR FEES IN RELATIONSHIP TO TREE AND VEGETATION PROTECTION AND PRESERVATION AND WETLAND APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1.20.010 of the Lacey Municipal Code, the Council passed Resolution 659 adopting a Lacey Fee Schedule, and,

WHEREAS, the City has passed a new ordinance relating to tree and vegetation protection and preservation to serve in lieu of the City's land clearing ordinance and has adopted a wetland ordinance, and it is necessary to specify the fees for processing applications and approvals relating to said subjects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that the Lacey Fee Schedule adopted by Resolution 659 is hereby amended to delete reference to land clearing under Chapter 14.32.040 of the Lacey Municipal Code and the fees relating thereto and adding to said fee schedule those certain subjects and fees set forth on that certain document entitled "Additions to Lacey Fee Schedule," attached hereto.

Additions to Lacey Fee Schedule

Tree and Vegetation Protection and Preservation -- 14.32.040

Exemption determinations by staff requiring site visit -0-

Hazard tree determinations requiring site visit
by tree protection professional \$25.00

Landclearing application and other land use permit
applications requiring compliance with the tree and
vegetation protection and preservation requirements:

single residential lot 1 acre or less and
commercial projects with less than 15 trees
not requiring work from the tree protection
professional \$60

residential lot 1 acre or larger, residential
projects with multiple lots, commercial
projects with 16 or more trees, and other
projects the City determines are complex
enough to require evaluation by the City's
tree protection professional. \$60 + actual
costs of tree
protection professional

Applicants will be responsible for actual costs of the
tree protection professional's work, including time
required to monitor project sites for compliance with tree
protection conditions. On projects where the estimated
cost will be over \$500, financial security may be required
to guarantee payment of actual costs.

Site Plan Review Committee consideration of a
wetland application \$200

Wetland application processed in conjunction with
another land use application requiring review by the
City Hearings Examiner \$400

Wetland application without another landuse application
requiring review by the City Hearings Examiner \$800
