**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND RESOURCE CONSERVATION PLAN FOR LACEY'S ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE/CRITICAL AREAS AND NATURAL RESOURCE LANDS IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE STATE GROWTH MANAGEMENT ACT AND AS PART OF THE CITY'S COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, as part of the development of the City's comprehensive land use plan and in order to satisfy the requirements of the State Growth Management Act, an Environmental Protection and Resource Conservation Plan has been developed, which Plan identifies and protects critical environmentally sensitive areas and valuable natural resource lands, and

WHEREAS, in developing said plan, the natural resource lands conservation portion has addressed agricultural lands, forest lands and mineral resource lands, and the critical areas protection portion addresses wetlands, aquifer recharge areas, frequently flooded areas, geologically hazardous areas and fish and wildlife habitat areas; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LACEY, WASHINGTON, that that certain plan entitled Environmental Protection and Resource Conservation Plan for Lacey's environmentally sensitive/critical areas and natural resource lands is hereby adopted and, shall become a part of the City's new comprehensive land use plan when the same is adopted in whole, and the City

Attorney is requested to present to the Council for passage at it's next regular meeting all new ordinances and amendments to existing ordinances called for in said plan and set forth in the appendix thereto.
